Step 4: Click the “Landing Card Data” button.

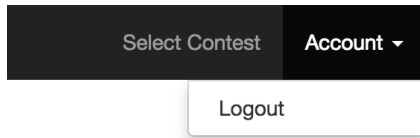

Step 7: Repeat Steps 5 & 6 for each of your assigned landing positions.

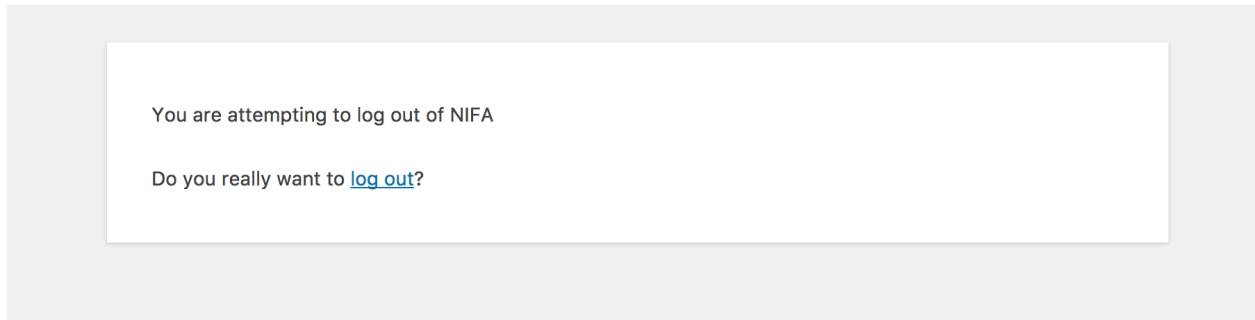
